Neuropsychology and Projective Tests

The neuropsychology of personality has been enriched with significant research achievements in the last decades. In particular, Rorschach and Adult Attachment Projective tests have been intensely explored with neuroimaging tools. The advent of specific diagnostic procedures (e.g. fMRI, PET, CT and EEG mu waves analysis) have opened doors in the understanding of brain functioning and damage, demonstrating neural connections and interactions between emotional and cognitive functioning.

In particular, the methods provide evidence of neural basis of attachment theory and social cognition, allowing a more in-depth examination of interpersonal relationship. The result is increased substantiation for the unique role of projective tests in personality assessment as well as important implications for clinical work. We have an exciting program with leading specialists in the field.
